Applying for Housing

Applying for housing can be quite daunting and there are lots of questions you may have. This information sheet will help answer them and get you started applying for a house.

What is the Highland Housing Register?

The Highland Housing Register is a single housing list shared between us and other registered social landlords in the Highlands region. This means you can apply for housing from any of the partner social landlords by completing a single shared application form.



Where are your houses?

We have over 700 properties throughout Lochaber, including rural areas in North, South, East and West Lochaber and throughout the Peninsula. The demand for housing is greater in some communities and this can influence how quickly you get an offer. You can view the locations here:

How are houses allocated?

When a house becomes available, a list of applicants from the Highland Housing Register is produced. Based on the points awarded, each house is allocated to the applicant who has the greatest need for that type and size of house in the community they have chosen.
