Lochaber Affordable Warmth Service is Launched

Lochaber Housing Association has been successful in obtaining substantial funding from the Social Housing Fuel Support Fund (via the SFHA) to help assist households struggling with their fuel bills.

A staggering 33% of households in the Highland region are now in fuel poverty. With costs continuing to rise this is only going to get worse...

LHA will be working in partnership with ALLenergy to provide not just advice but financial assistance to those in need, aiming to reduce fuel poverty for it's tenants.

Financial assistance via the Lochaber Affordable Warmth Service (LAWS) fund is NOT a loan and NOT repayable by you.

Contact your Housing Officer today to see if you are eligible for up to 3 x £49 credit vouchers for your meter or up to £250 towards your fuel bill and potential ongoing financial support, depending on your circumstances.

Funding expires 31st March, so don't delay, contact us today.
